

**Module Title:** Aḥkām

**Module Code:** FIQAHK

**Course Duration:** 17 Weeks

**Teaching Method:** 2 units/week

**Credits:** 10

### **Overview:**

This module aims to give students a thorough grounding in substantive knowledge of *aḥkām sharʿiyya* and the technical terminology (*istilāḥāt*) of the discourse as found in the classical work of *Al-Lumʿa Al-Dimashqiyya* of Shahīd al-Awwal. Each weekly session (2 units) will be divided into two parts. The first part will consist of an English based lecture orientating the students to the central issues of the theme under consideration, their most relevant *aḥkām*, and a discussion of the relevant Arabic terminology and English equivalents for these terms. The second part of each week's session will engage with a close reading (*taṭbīq*) of selected passages from the core text.
